Ole Gunnar Austvik is professor of political economy and of petroleum economics, currently at Inland Norway University - Oslo, Lillehammer. Appointed Senior Fellow at John F. Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University, and has inter alia been working with the Norwegian Institute of International Affairs (NUPI), BI Norwegian Business School and Statistics Norway. By education he holds a doctorate in political science and master in economics (cand.oecon - sosialøkonomisk embetseksamen) from University of Oslo, and a Master in Public Administration (MPA) from Harvard Kennedy School. Professor Austvik is the author of numerous articles and books regarding public policy, international political economy, European integration, global energy economics and policy.
